



# St Edmund's CHILDREN'S CHURCH TRAIL ANSWER SHEET

Thank you for visiting our peaceful Church which is a Grade 1 listed Building that has been the heart of the local community since the year 1190

We hope you have enjoyed the Church Trail , and a chance to look at just some of the details of our Church Building. The Chancel contains the four Montagu Monuments which commemorate four members of the Montagu family, spanning three generations from nearby Boughton House.

Two of the sculptors were created by Louis Francois Roubilliac, who is considered to have been one of the greatest sculptors working in 18th century England
